NEW PARKING METERS ON ABBOT KINNEY BLVD

The Office of Councilmember Mike Bonin and the City of Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) will host a Community Open House in Venice to discuss the proposed installation of new smart parking meters, metered motorcycle parking, and micromobility stations along Abbot Kinney Boulevard in early 2020.

LADOT recently implemented LA ExpressPark™ demand based parking pricing into the Venice area and plans to expand the program to the Abbot Kinney corridor in the near future. The LA ExpressPark™ program uses an intelligent parking management system to manage smart parking meters that will accept coins, credit cards, and payment via mobile apps to pay for parking.

LADOT will present details about the project at the Open House, will answer questions, and will accept comments from the public.
